Job advert: law tuition coordinator

The London Learning Cooperative and the Materialist Lawyers' Group have entered into a collaborative partnership, and we are recruiting! We are looking for a part-time law tuition coordinator to co-design and deliver group and 1-to-1 legal education courses, aiming to commence the course(s) in July 2020.

About LLC

LLC is a radically inclusive, internationalist, and anti-imperialist tuition agency in the pursuit of creating a global network. We connect students wanting to learn languages and other skills with tutors in formerly and currently colonised societies like Palestine, Pakistan and Ireland. We seek to discuss and understand imperialism in order to set about reversing its flows of wealth, people, knowledge and power.

MLG, with whom we are coordinating this course, is a group of practicing lawyers and academics who are interested in critically interrogating the law's function in favor of departing from the idealist notion that law provides the only effective remedies for those genuinely lacking power. Together we develop a materialist legal praxis.

LLC have spent the last several years developing our international network of tutors. We currently have a presence in France, Britain, Ireland's occupied six counties, Pakistan, Venezuela and Palestine. We're now seeking to expand our focus on language into radical, materialist legal education.

LLC is committed to four principles:

1. Radically inclusive pricing. Students pay what they can afford for a lesson.
2. Learning as a dialogue aimed at understanding and transforming society and the economy.
3. Creating bonds of solidarity between imperial core and periphery.
4. Workers' power and democratic, cooperative governance.

About the role

The role has four key components:

- Development of a basic legal education syllabus, aimed in particular at practicing lawyers and lawyers-in-training, and with an emphasis on anti-imperialist and anti-capitalist legal praxis (unity of theory and practice).

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- Designing courses, and recruiting teachers from among practicing lawyers and legal academics to deliver them.
- Collaborating with LLC staff to generally develop and grow our legal tuition programmes across classes and years
- Coordinating with our existing tutors to ensure that all courses offered have an anti-imperialist understanding and assessing how we can offer courses on the legal structures within formerly and currently colonised societies.

Applicant's essential skills/experience/characteristics:

1. Proven ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
2. Legal knowledge is essential. The ideal candidate will be training to be, or qualified as, a solicitor or barrister in England and Wales (however please do apply if you are not qualified or training in these jurisdictions and we can discuss).
3. Teaching experience.
4. Ability to use Zoom and other online applications when teaching.
5. Uninterrupted access to a good quality computer and high speed internet connection.
6. Commitment to the principles of LLC, as set out above.

Applicant's desirable attributes/experiences:

1. Social media skills.
2. Some proficiency in Arabic and/or Irish.
